Georgia's Macroeconomy at a Glance: Growth Slowed in September on Weak Domestic, External Demand Conditions

The Georgian economy's growth rate appeared to slow down in September. According to Gaostat's rapid estimates forecast, real growth of GDP decreased to 4.1%. This estimate is the lowest this year since April, when the growth rate fell to 2.7%.



Khachapuri index: Georgia is Becoming a Cheaper Country, Particularly for Foreigners

Real Estate Price Index: Average Rental, Sale Prices Decline in October, Driven by Supply and Quality

The average cost of cooking one standard Imeretian Khachapuri in November 2014 was 3.34 GEL, which

is 0.2% lower month-on-month (m/m, that is compared to the previous month), and 2.4% lower year-on-year (y/y, that is compared to the same month of last year). However, Khachapuri became even cheaper for foreign currency earners because of a sudden GEL depreciation (m/m and y/y) relative to USD and EUR during the last two weeks of November.



0.16 points higher y/y. Through this "double effect" (a seasonal decrease in Kh-Index and devaluation of the local currency), the Khachapuri price expressed in USD lost 4.7% m/m and 10.8% y/y.
